



“Hearthstone provides a safe, loved, loving and engaged environment for each individual, so that they can live their lives with dignity and respect in the community.”



Gentle Teaching Philosophy

Our Hearthstone community is guided by the values and philosophy of Gentle Teaching.



This is not just “something we do at work”, it breathes our organizational culture.

As Gentle Teachers we are disciplined, not disciplining. We focus on inner healing rather than emphasizing focus on behavioral change. We believe in total acceptance of each person and want to help others to become as active as possible in their own lives.

Residential Services

We currently have six residential homes in the Selkirk area. We will assist you with the activities of daily living and support you with any emotional and social needs out in the community. If you make the decision to join our Adult Day Program, you can look forward to being driven to and from program!

Transportation Services

We try our best to accommodate your transportation needs.



Kindly note transportation arrangements are discussed on a case by case basis when we meet together after your tour.

Before & After School Program

This service provides a unique experience to assist young adults still in school, (identified and supported by Family Services), who require care in the morning before school and/or after school.

Hours of operation: Monday to Fridays
Morning: 7:45 am - 9:00 am
Afternoon: 3:30 pm - 6:00 pm



The school bus will come to Hearthstone in the morning to pick you up, then after school, it will drop you back off.

Transitions can feel uncomfortable. One goal of this program is to help, ease transitioning from high school into Adult Day Program.

If you decide that Hearthstone is the place to go after graduation, you can feel confident and at ease, knowing you are surrounded by people who you are familiar with.

Services may be purchased from us privately or we are able to work with families' FS Case worker to arrange funding. (Funding is not guaranteed and is determined on a case by case basis)

Adult Day Program

This program serves as an opportunity for you to build new skills and engage with us in a positive learning environment.

This person centred program will help you build new relationships, and give you the chance to go out together on a variety of outings as a group. We also structure and provide you choice options when you're deciding upon work experience and personal goals.
